

REGISTRY OF SEAGOING VESSELS REGISTRATION

DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED

1.	Application for registration (2 copies) (form 92);
2.	<p><i>Either</i> certificate of deletion issued by the primary registry of the country where the vessel was last registered; this certificate shall evidence the identity of the last known owner(s) well ass the status encumbrances of the vessel</p> <p><i>Either</i> certificate of non-registration issued by the competent authority of the country of the construction site and/or of the residence of the last foreign owner</p>
3.	<p>The deed of establishment, transfer or designation of the rights of ownership or usufruct, if it is a private deed, or a certified copy, if it is an authentic deed. A duplicate of the private deed or a copy of the authentic deed must be attached and will remain at the office of the Belgian Ship Registry. These deeds must be registered in advance at a registration office of FPS Finance.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * (e.g. Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with copy of bill of sale & protocol of delivery and acceptance) * construction agreement * deed of sale and purchase * invoice signed "ready for sale" by the seller and "ready for purchase" by the buyer etc ...) <p>-if it concerns a new construction of a foreign yard: two originals and pre-registered copies of the "protocol of delivery and acceptance "for determining the delivery of the ship by the yard</p>
4.	a declaration by Belgian notary confirming that the applicant fulfills the conditions of the articles 14 to 17 of the Royal Decree on registration of seagoing vessels of 26 June 2020;
5.	the deeds relating to the authorizations required by Articles 15 and 16 of the Royal Decree on registration of seagoing vessels of 26 June 2020;

6.	a copy of the registration of the registered operator in the “Kruispuntbank van ondernemingen”;
	<p>Additional documents if requested by the Belgian Ship Registry:</p> <p>-if the application is submitted by or on behalf of a foreign legal entity: a copy of the deeds containing the articles of association and amendments of the articles of association as well as a statement by a notary public regarding the names, the domicile and nationality of the directors, of the joint and several liable partners or of the holders of registered shares or those of the business managers;</p> <p>- the certificate of nationality of each of the natural persons and the articles of association of each of the legal persons who own or co-own the seagoing vessel; -a copy of the tonnage certificate; -a sworn translation of any deed or written in a language other than one of the national languages;</p>
