(f) A TRI(A) may instruct in a TRI(A) course once he or she has demonstrated 50 hours of instructional experience as a TRI or SFI and has conducted the flight instruction syllabus of the TRI training course under the supervision and to the satisfaction of a qualified TRI nominated by the HT of an ATO.
