- You have to provide us with a copy of your medical certificate issued in conformity with Part-MED.

Furthermore, in case of obtaining the pilot licence, rating or certificate by falsification of submitted documentary evidence, in spite of the penalties susceptible to be imposed on the pilot, the decision of acceptance will be the object of a decision of immediate withdrawal.

Instruction time must be certified in your logbook by the appropriately rated or authorised instructor from whom it was received.
