

Declaration for Revalidation of a Certificate of Proficiency V/3 §7 (§9 IGF Liq. gas tanker experience)
(Adv. Training for ships subject to the IGF Code)

With reference to Regulation V/3 §9 (**IGF Liquefied gas tanker experience**) and Section A-V/3 §2 of the STCW Convention 1978, as amended, every candidate for recertification “Advanced training for ships subject to the IGF Code – V/3 §7”:

- 1°) a) Has actively followed minimum one bunkering operations on board ships subject to the IGF Code (two of the three bunkering operations may be replaced by approved simulator training on bunkering operations as part of the approved training program), or

b) Or has participated in one cargo operations on board a liquefied gas tanker.
- 2°) Demonstrated the competence to undertake the tasks, duties and responsibilities listed in column 1 of Table A-V/3-2.

 - the minimum knowledge, understanding and proficiency listed in column 2 of table A-V/3-2, and
 - the required standard of competence in accordance with the methods for demonstrating competence and the criteria for evaluating competence tabulated in columns 3 and 4 of table A-V/3-2.
