1. Segregation requirements: the minimum distance between **UN 1080 (class 2.2) and UN 1219, UN1268 (class 3)** must be **3 metres**;
2. all other applicable requirements of the IMDG Code are complied with;
3. every shipment is accompanied with a copy of this approval which should be made available on request by any authorised authority.
4. The shipper shall report any incident involving loss of packaging contents or packaging failure to the Belgian Competent Authority.

This approval shall be withdrawn if any of the above conditions are breached or if the Administration considers to do so.

This approval is subject to a payment of **EUR 96,00**.
