



NOTICE TO OPERATORS 10/03

Subject: STD user approval

- Description:**
- (a) According to Annex III of Regulation 3922/91 OPS 1.005 (d), the use of STD by an operator shall obtain approval from the Authority (BCAA).
 - (b) The Belgian operators shall transmit, with his application for approval, the following documents to BCAA (to the principal operations surveyor concerned) for each STD used:
 - the STD qualification certificate,
 - a difference list between the STD used and the operated aircraft,
 - the additional training and alternative means used to perform the required training in despite of those differences, this shall be incorporated in the OM D.
 - (c) The BCAA can ask for a demonstration of the training (simulator and additional training).
 - (d) If the documents above are acceptable, the BCAA will issue the simulator user approval forms.
 - (e) A STD user approval can be revoked or suspend if:
 - the STD qualification certificate is not valid anymore,
 - there are modification to the STD and/or to the aircraft which affect the usability with regard to the operator's training program.
 - (f) The operator shall notify the BCAA without delay any modification to the STD and/or to its aircraft that might affect the usability of the simulator to conduct the operator's training program.
 - (g) When a new STD is used by an operator, it is the responsibility of the operator to ask the BCAA a STD user approval. A training done with a STD not approved by the BCAA won't be recognized by the BCAA.

- (h) The operators shall send the application and the documents above for all STD used to the BCAA before the 1st of October 2010.
- (i) From the 15th of January 2011, a training done with a STD not approved by the BCAA won't be recognized by the BCAA.
